**Congratulations** - The outstanding work of the many volunteers of Donaghmore Horticultural Community was recognised last week when Donaghmore won the 2025 "Best Kept Village" category in Ireland's Best Kept Town competition. Judging criteria included how the village was free from litter, posters and graffiti, the neatness and tidiness of the houses and gardens, the absence of weeds growing on the footpaths, all public areas are clean and tidy and that there is an array of floral displays. The judges also looked for good community support in helping the group with its work. To be eligible for consideration in the Ireland's Best Kept Town competition the village had to be the Best Kept Village in Northern Ireland which was awarded to Donaghmore in October 2024.
